



Johann Friedrich Wilhelm KOCH

Friedrich was born in Rakau, Brandenburg, Prussia in 1826. He was 12 years old when he and his family arrived at Port Misery SA. He was confirmed in 1842 at Hoffnungstahl.

When Friedrich was 23 years of age, he married Wilhelmine Ernestine Warnest 29 November 1849 by Pastor HAE Mayer at Bethany. Their witnesses were Gottlieb Koch and Karoline Bohm.

Johann Friedrich Wilhelm KOCH (First born son)

Friedrich was baptised 18 October 1850 by Pastor HAE Mayer at the Bethany Herberge Christi Church, with his sponsors being Johanne Louise Warnest, Johann Samuel Schulz and Johann Gottlieb Koch.

He married Louise Fredericke Bertha Geue, the daughter of a farmer and publican. On 3 November 1875, JFW Koch took up land at Kilkerran which he and his family farmed, and as it has been said his reason for moving was 'there were just too many Koch's in the Barossa area' and he wanted to move further afield. Unfortunately Friedrich's wife died in 1883 leaving him with 4 young children.

In 1884 Friedrich married Auguste Albertine Braunack aged 27 years and living at St Kitt's at the time. They married at Ebenezer with Pastor Joh Christian Auricht officiating. The newly-married couple then went to live on his farm at Kilkerran.

Friedrich passed away in 1909 and Auguste, with the help of her neighbours continued managing the farm. When her youngest son, Jacob married, she left to live with her daughters in Adelaide, Parana and Rowland Flat. She passed away on her birthday in 1935 at Rowland Flat and was buried next to her husband at the South Kilkerran cemetery.

The farm is now owned by his grandsons Keith and Denis Koch, and in 1975, centenary celebrations were held on the original farm with a cairn and plaque, placed in what once was the front garden of JFW's home.

While at Orlando, he developed an intense interest in winemaking which fostered a natural and acquired ability as he worked and finally establishing a winery of his own having also studied South African, Californian and other Australian methods in the art of making top quality wines. He began winemaking in 1944 and in 1948 left Orlando and bought the small winery which his father had previously established in 1918 in the old butchering buildings. Bill, with the help of his wife Norma, continued to expand St Hallett Winery from a storage of 21,000 galls to 200,000 galls of top quality wines. >

Selma grew up and received her education at Kilkerran, and married her husband, Johannes Heinrich 'Jack' Koch, son of Johann Wilhelm Koch and Magdalena (nee Altus) of Peterborough. (Her husband is not a descendant of Friedrich Koch). They made their home at South Kilkerran on a farming property. They soon moved to Pinnaroo, travelling by horse and trap, where other members of his family had moved to, to begin a new life. Farming at Pinnaroo was not easy due to poor soil conditions and the climate was not suitable for mixed farming. Their home at times would have been filled with music as Jack was an enthusiastic member of the Brass Band and many musical friends also came to visit. Later in life, he enjoyed singing in the church choir.

Ernst grew up on the Yorke Peninsular in the area of Kilkerran and Maitland. Ernst was a member of the 1st class to be received at Concordia College, Adelaide, where he received his secondary education.

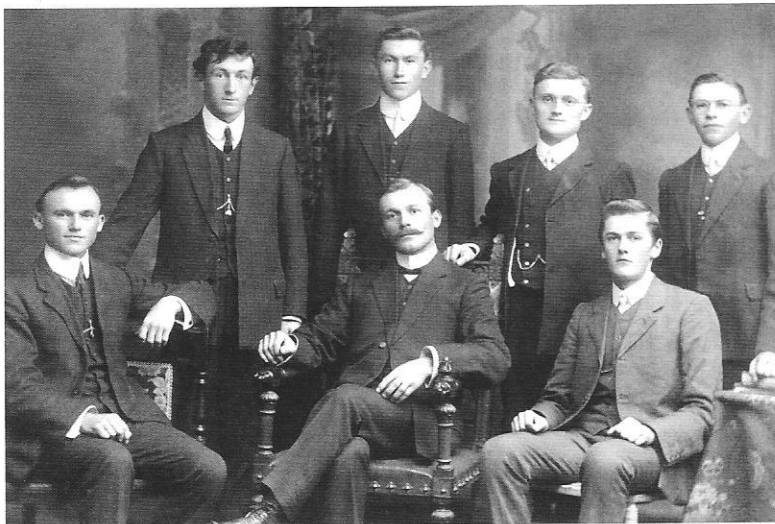
Ernst served as a teacher in the Lutheran Schools of Bower, Emu Downs and Gindera NSW.

His special gift was his love of music, which later enabled him to become a music teacher. He commenced his music studies under Mr Harold Tracey, an enthusiastic teacher of the piano at Albury NSW and did further studies at the Elder Conservatorium under Mr GJ Reimann (piano) and Mr TH Jones (theory and harmony).

Ernst began teaching music at Tanunda in 1919 and taught for 45 years in the Barossa Valley.

In 1927 he married Anna Aurora Kies, with Pastor Basedow officiating. They spent their married life in Tanunda and were members of St Paul's Lutheran Church. Ernst enjoyed good health except for a brief illness just before his death, in 1965.

Anna remarried Traugott Julius Hampel and passed away after 14 years of marriage to her second husband, after suffering from a stroke. She was laid to rest with Ernst in the Lyndoch cemetery.

He at all times fearlessly contended for the faith, and repeatedly sought to impress on both clergy and laity the need to reach out to non-Christians with the Gospel. The cause of Aboriginal missions was particularly dear to his heart.

The Church used Dr Clem's special God-given gifts in many ways. He served the New Zealand District as president from 1958 to 1964. He held the same office in SA from 1973 till his death. In 1981 he was elected first vice-president of the LCA. He was also a member of many councils, boards and commissions of the Church, such as the Joint Union Committee, the Councils of Luther Seminary and Lutheran Teachers College, the Board for Church Development, the Board of Aboriginal Missions, the Finke River Mission Board and the Commission on Theology and Inter-Church Relations.

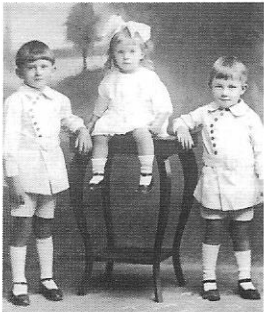
Dr Clem was a keen student throughout his life and was gifted with deep theological insights. In addition to the many Bible studies and papers he prepared and presented at >

God's gift to Vera began with her baptism on 20 May 1923, at South Kilkerran, Yorke Peninsula, the late Pastor CE Hoopmann officiating. A further gift was at the time of her confirmation, also at South Kilkerran on 20 November 1937. This time it was Pastor HW Harnath officiating. Then a further gift of God came on the day of her marriage to Ivan 'Pat' Roll in 1956, with Pastor B Traeger officiating.

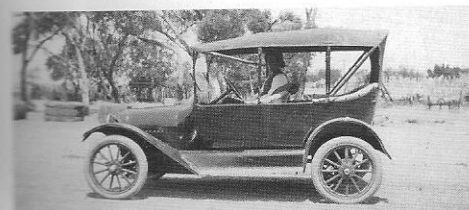

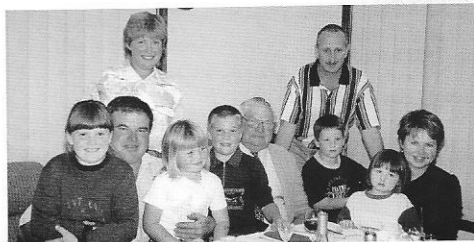
